



Edsbyn Factory

The secret of our success is the ability to change and adapt. What began in 1899 as a small carpentry, grew in to be one of the largest furniture factories in the Nordics. Between 1934 and 1984, we produced wooden skis for the Ministry of Defence, Olympic gold medal winners, and families. From the waste material, we manufactured pin-back chairs, which became well-known and cherished in Swedish homes.

As one of Sweden's oldest furniture companies, with roots in Edsbyn, we can proudly say that we have played a part in making the label Swedish Design synonymous with good form and function.
